Film to feature race, workers' rights, and exploitation of immigrants

Mississippi Chicken, a film about Latin American immigrants living in rural Mississippi and working in the poultry industry, will make its Ohio debut at 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday, May 12, at the Gateway Film Center, 1550 N. High Street. The film screening will be followed by a panel discussion exploring issues of race, workers' rights, and exploitation and featuring the filmmakers and organizers from the Ohio-based Immigrant Worker Project.

The event, hosted by the Kirwan Institute and sponsored by the Migration Transnationalism, and Border Politics Working Group, the Center for Latin American Studies, the Department of Sociology, and Reform Immigration for America-Ohio, is free and open to the public.
